Emergency appeal for flood affected areas in Croatia



Parts of Croatia, Bosnia and Serbia have been affected by catastrophic flooding.

Unfortunately, these days in the flooded areas, many were left without basic things without which we cannot imagine life, without homes and without a source of income. These are areas that are not rich, people who live from agriculture and crafts, which now except their property have lost their jobs, their income and their life's.



Ministry of Agriculture intensively is continue to implement all activities related to the remediation of damage to agriculture and the extraction and placement of animals from flooded areas. According to the first preliminary estimates of possible damage to agriculture (direct damage to crops, orchards and livestock) could reach over 13 million euros, although it is still difficult to give the right assess of the damage extent.

The Republic of Croatia has 1.026.701 hectares of agricultural land. According to current estimates by the Ministry of Agriculture, under the water is a total of 5.178 hectares of agricultural land which is 0.50 % of all agricultural land in Croatia. For the most part flooded crops are grains and oilseeds (soybeans 34.02 %, 27.63 % wheat, corn 23.60 %).



So far, from flooded areas have been evacuated 7.665 from total of 11.918 registered animals (approximately 65% of the animals). Although the data is changing from hour to hour in the course of the disposal of the remaining uncared animals.

For the people who have lost all property, all of the fields, workshops in the flood, to whom cattle and what little domestic animals they had for their own needs died, or escaped or are lost, recovery will take a long time period.

The final damage assessment will be possible only when water from flooded areas is withdrawn and after an inspection of the crop and complete records of all animals and damage caused to buildings and agricultural mechanization is done.



Many people have literally overnight lost everything, so let's not forget what it means to be human.

For their recovery and return to normal life it will certainly take longer than a year.
